Red-footed Tortoises

(Chelonoidis carbonaria)



STATUS: Least concern (IUCN Red List)	HABITAT: Terrestrial - dry grasslands and humid forests
DIET: Mainly herbivorous - grasses and flowers, but will also eat insects.	ACTIVE: Diurnal; active during the day, sleeps at night
LIFESPAN: 20-30 years in wild, 30-60 years in captivity	OFFSPRING: Clutch size up to 15 eggs, incubation period of 150 days.
LENGTH: Male carapace length - 13.5 inches ; female carapace length - 11.25	WEIGHT: Average of 10 pounds; however, males can weigh up to 20 pounds.
